## The State of the Family in Canada

- A shift in our value for the rights of the unborn. Our nation has terminated the life of over 4 million unborn children in the past 30 years.
- A shift in our value for covenant in marriage. Our government has legislated easy divorce laws.
- A shift in our morals. Our nation was one of the first countries in the world to legislate same-sex marriage in 2004.

Why the Shift in Canadian Values?

The # 1 Reason: Fatherlessness and the breakdown of the family.

### A Fatherless Generation:

- 40% of children are born out of wedlock in Canada.
- 23.6% of children lived in father- absent homes in 2014.
- A Canadian survey suggested that 65 out of 100 of youth in Canada will not be living with both biological parents when they graduate from high school.
- Fathers may be present in the home but absent from their families.

## Children who grow up fatherless are:

- 8 times more likely to go to prison.
- 5 times more likely to commit suicide.
- 20 times more likely to have behavioural problems.
- 10 times as likely to not get A's in school.

## Signs of a Wounded Heart

  - Performance: Keep busy to fill the empty place in our hearts.
  - Passions: Hidden sins and iniquities that cause many leaders to fall.
  - Possessions: bigger house, bigger church, bigger holiday.

## **Session 3: How to Write a Blessing**

- 1. God's intention is that the Blessing would answer the identity questions in a child's life.
  - Blessing affirms their value as a son or daughter.
  - Blessing affirms their gender as male or female.
  - Blessings affirm their true identity in Christ.
- 2. Blessing identity answers the question "Who am I?"
- 3. Barriers to blessing.
  - Not separating identity from behaviour.
  - Not repenting for relational messages that we send

## Five Elements of the Blessing:

1.	Appropriate meaningful touch
2.	A spoken word
3.	Attach high value to the one being blessed
4.	Picture a special future for the one being blessed

5. Express an active commitment to fulfil the blessing
Step 1: Capture the Blessing in 3 Paragraphs
